Covid Measures in Church

- Maintaining a social distance of 2 metres from others at all times

- Completing the pew sheet with your contact details and leaving it in the birdcage upon exiting.

As the weather turns colder, we suggest you wear warm clothes to church; in order to keep you safe, we need to have the windows open to ensure a good circulation of air.
